**One-day Excursions**

\* **Avachinsky Volcano Pass Hike/Picnic**- 8-hour trip - 10:00 Drive to the pass between Koriyanskiy (3456 m) and Avachinsky (2941 m) by 4WD, the drive usually takes about 1.5 hours from our guest house. With a picnic lunch and guide, hike up to Camel Rock, about 4 km. If the weather is fine and you are fit, you may continue and hike up on the shoulder of Avachinsky Volcano. This active volcano steams constantly, and last erupted in 1991. Explore the pass, photograph wildflowers, amidst volcanic terrain. Enjoy the view to the valley, city, and bay below. Visit the small Volcanoes of Kamchatka Nature Park information site. Depart the volcanic pass by 17:00 and return to the guest house.

\* **Marine tour to Starichkov Island** - Tour departs daily from the port, one tour leaving the harbor at 9:00 and the other at 15:00. Comfortable boats (10-20 passengers) take visitors out Avacha Bay south to this seabird colony named for the Ancient Murrelets which nest there. Along with these auklets, one may see Common Murres, Tufted Puffins, Black-legged Kittiwakes, Cormorants, and numerous gulls. Some years Steller Sea Eagles nest on a nearby rock pinnacle. Cruise around the rock several times. then the boat goes nearer shore and people get to try deep sea fishing. Lunch is served. Ammenities include toilets and a covered cabin area for shelter. Depart the guest house by 7:45 AM for 9:00 AM tour, and 13:45 for 15:00 tour. Includes lunch, transfers to/from port and the guest house, and English speaking guide.

\* **Goryely Volcano** - Arise early and depart the guest house by 4WD by 7:00 for a wild and rough ride to Goryely Volcano, which means “burnt.” This active volcano can be ascended on a trail in about 1.5 hours to the crater rim. If weather is fine, this gives a view of a vast volcanic vista in almost every direction. Enjoy a picnic with your guide and group. If time allows, following your descent from the volcano, visit the ice cave, which is a remnant of the huge snowfall in the area over many past winters. Return by evening to the guest house. Includes: 4WD transportation, guide, and picnic.

\* **City tour of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky and Khalaktersky Beach** - 8 hour tour. Depart your guest house at 9:30 by car, with an English speaking guide, driving to Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky. En route, stop at the Bear monument “Where Russia Begins,” to take photographs with the huge volcanoes in the background. Visit the scenic overlook above the harbor in Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky to get an overview of the most historic area of the city. Visit the Regional Museum and learn about the Peninsula’s history, culture, and nature. Walk along the port area, visiting some of the monuments to Kamchatka’s history. Stop at souvenir shops. Have lunch (no host) in a local cafe. Visit the fish market, the Russian Orthodox cathedral, and go up Mission Hill for a view of the city and bay. Drive northeast of the city to the black sand Khalaktersky Beach. Walk on the beach, see the visitor center signage about the birds and sea mammals one may see there. Includes: English speaking guide, transportation, museum entrance fee. Excursion length 8 hours.

\* **Snow Dog Kennel and Program about Kamchatka’s Aboriginal People**- Spend 3 hours visiting the husky dog kennel of Kamchatka’s most accomplished dog mushers Andrey and Anastasiya Semyashkin, located just outside of the city, nestled into the woods and tundra below Avachinsky Volcano. The Semyashkins have a beautiful place to learn about Kamchatka dog mushing, and to experience a taste of Kamchatka aboriginal culture. Andrey Semyashkin is of Aleut-Russian heritage, and he and his family have brought together other aboriginal people of Kamchatka to offer entertaining, and informative programs about the clothing, dance, and music of Kamchatka’s cultures. They also have started raising reindeer. The excursion includes: transfers from/to the guesthouse to their facility, the tour, an English speaking guide, and lunch.
